
Percentage of Students Receiving Support

In the past 4 years, the percentage of students with IEPs/OAPs and the percentage of students in the AIM process (without IEPs/OAPs) have increased.



Number of Students in the AIM Process

Since SY 2010-2011, the number of students in the AIM process has increased in middle school and high school school, while in elementary school the number of students in the AIM Process has ranged from 37 to 47.

Number of Students with Identified Needs (IEPs/OAPs)

Since SY 2010-2011, the number of students with identified needs (meaning, students with an IEP or OAP) has increased in elementary school and middle school, while in high school the number of students with identified needs has ranged from 17 to 23.
