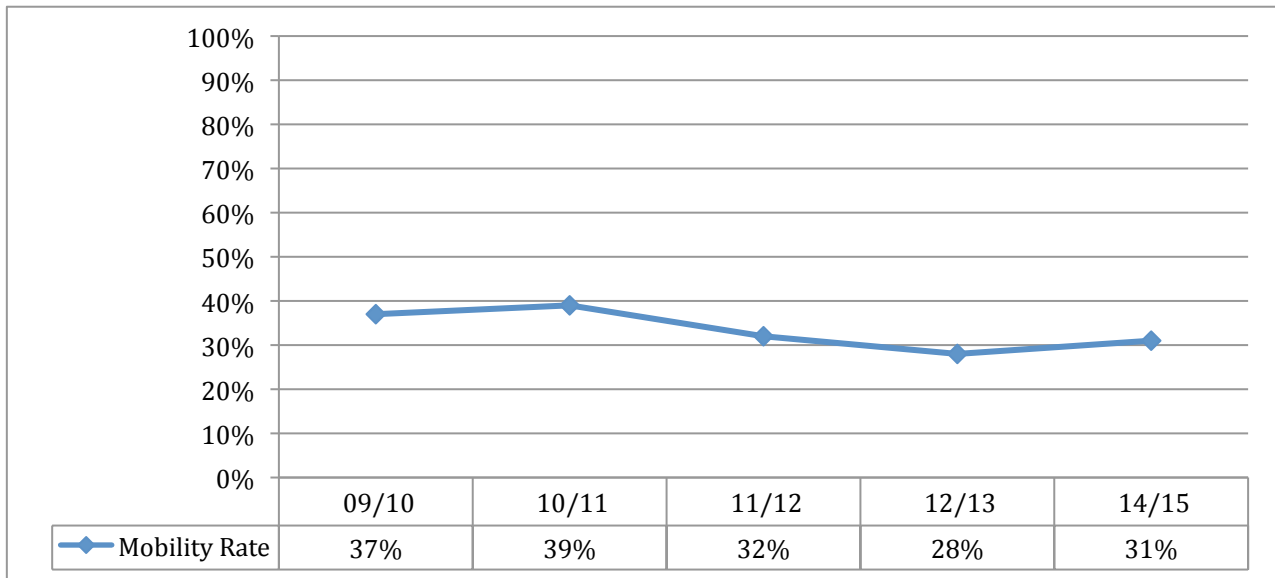


Mobility

In the past 5 years, mobility has ranged from 28% to 39%.

Note:

- Mobility % = (number of new and returning students + number of students leaving)/total number of students
- An economic recession started in 2008, and there was an earthquake/tsunami in March 2011.



Mobility Breakdown

Generally speaking, the new and returning number of students is greater than the number of students who left. The total number of returning students ranged from 6 to 17, the total number of new students ranged from 59 to 93, and the total number of new students who left ranged from 32 to 98.

Note: An economic recession started in 2008, and there was an earthquake/tsunami in March 2011.
